transformer bay, 2 no. line bays and all associated electrical equipment, services and lighting within an up to
2.95 metre high fenced compound (with a total footprint of 13,100 square metres);
ii. 2 no. lattice-type strain towers with a maximum height of up to 21m and approximately 70m of 110kV
overhead electricity lines to facilitate connection of the proposed substation to the permitted 110kV LaoisKilkenny Grid Reinforcement Project electricity transmission line (An Bord Pleanála Reference PL11.VA0015);
iii. Approximately 0.65km of on-site access track with associated site entrance from local public road (L77951); and
iv. All associated and ancillary site development, excavation, construction, landscaping and reinstatement
works, including provision of site drainage infrastructure and surface water protection measures.
